Attire:

- Only dark blue or black jeans are permitted. Long sleeved shirt tucked into pants. Long sleeved shirt is defined as a western style long sleeve shirt with buttons or snaps down the front. The shirt will have a fold down collar that can have a button. NO SWEAT SHIRTS, TURTLENECKS, "SLINKIES", T-SHIRTS, PULLOVER SWEATERS OR VESTS. Per AQHA rule #445(e), judges, at their discretion, may authorize adjustments to attire due to weather-related conditions.
- Ties, scarves and gloves are optional.
- Western hats, or ASTM/SEI approved helmet, must be worn in ALL Western classes. A western hat or helmet must be worn during Barrel Racing and Pole Bending in accordance with AQHA rules. A Five second penalty will be accessed if the hat or helmet is not on the exhibitor's person for the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena for pole bending, stake race, flag race, and barrel racing. No Caps.
- The gates must be closed before a contestant can run in a speed event. Disqualification will occur if the contestant starts the run prior to the gates being closed.
- In order to be eligible for the All-Around prize you must compete in both a performance class and a timed event.
- In case a tie occurs, the horse in the open division, respectively, will be declared the all-around who: 1) earned credits in the greatest number of events 2) The horse or contestant winning over the greatest number of horses 3) Earned the most credits in performance events.
- NO CHAPS except in Reining where chaps are optional.

Appropriate Hunt Seat Class attire will be per AQHA #445 (2007 Rulebook).
